Phonics screening check

All children in Year 1 will be taking the phonics screening check between Monday 12th - Wednesday 14th June. Each child will take the test with myself in one of our intervention rooms. Children will have as much time as they need to work their way through the 40 word booklet. Praise and encouragement will be given throughout the test to ensure they feel confident and calm! We have been preparing for the test all year and children are very familiar with the process.

Next week is bike week. As part of our engagement in the week, your child will be allowed to bring their bike or scooter into school as part of one of our P.E sessions.
