- Used expanded column method to subtract numbers. Some of us have also compacted this method.
- Written stories based on the Stone Age Boy book.
- Used paragraphs and adverbials in our writing.
- Found out about Stone Age food, artefacts, life and the settlement of Skara Brae.

- Logins for the Times Table Rock stars App will be sent out soon.
- There will be a heavy focus on times tables and your help with this is needed. We will probably have to go beyond our 3s,4s and 8s this year. Some of the class have already made fantastic progress with their times tables and it is testament to the work they have done at home.
- Weekly spellings are tricky but all come from the year 3 curriculum. Repeated daily practice will help.
- With regards to writing the expectation is for children to be able to write at length up to and beyond a page of A4 paper.
