Next week: 'Goldilocks'

This week I have been

- Revising previously taught phonics or learning to read, write and spell with **y z zz qu**
- Recognising numbers to 10, saying the number that is 1 more or 1 less than a number up to 10
- Singing counting songs including '10 in the Bed' and 'counting to 100'
- Weighing ingredients in balance scales and making my own biscuit bears (6 of us - but we will all get a turn this term)
- Doing handwriting - correct formation of 'a' and 'b'
- Making a chair for baby bear (some of us)
- Listening to a radio story 'The House of the Bears'
- Painting a portrait of a bear (some of us)
- Acting out the story of 'Goldilocks'
- Discussing what Goldilocks did that was wrong, why it was wrong and what she could have done instead of running away.
- Doing music with a supply teacher
- Doing gymnastics in PE - revising different jumps, using some apparatus and putting a series of 3 jumps into a sequence with a partner
- Listening to stories - 'Goldilocks & the Three Bears', 'Bears', 'Hide & Seek', 'We're Going on a Bear Hunt' and 'A Quiet Night in'
- Singing 'Bobby Shaftoe', 'When Goldilocks went to the house of the Bears'
