

This week the children have been:

- Learning about the features of non-chronological reports (headings, sub-headings, facts and information organised into paragraphs, etc). They have seen and read many different examples linked to our topic of The Romans.
- Using different websites to research the life of a Roman soldier. Next week they will be using the facts they have collected to write a non-chronological report.
- Identifying pronouns and learning about how these are used to replace nouns in a sentence.
- Using apostrophes for plural possession (for example: The boys' shoes were dirty. The children's classroom was empty.)
- Securing their understanding of written multiplication and moving onto division of 2 digit numbers.
- Designing and creating a Roman mosaic.



For their homework this week, the children need to log on to the ActiveLearn website where I have set an interactive game which will help them to revise and improve their recall of the 3 and 4 times table facts. This is a tablet/iPad friendly game. If they are unable to complete this at home, then I will offer a lunchtime homework club session on Wednesday.

We have already had some amazing creations and pieces of work handed in linked to our Roman topic. I know weekends can be busy, so thank you for supporting your child if they have managed to complete one of the additional homework tasks.
