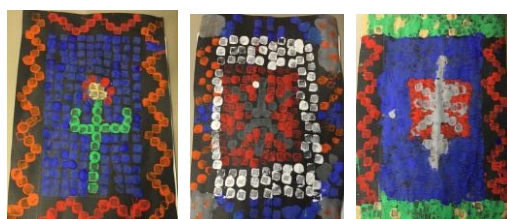


This week the children have been:

- Drafting paragraphs for their own non-chronological reports about Roman Soldiers. They have used organisational features such as headings and sub-headings.
- Learning about the legacy of the Roman Empire in Britain.
- Dividing 2 and 3 digit numbers by 1 digit numbers and working with remainders.
- Learning about how we calculate the area of simple shapes by counting squares.
- Playing mini squash tournaments and developing their sending and receiving skills in Lacrosse.
- Finishing off their printed Roman mosaics and testing the strength of different arches in DT.
