This week the children have;

- Written our version of the 'Alien Landing' story.
- Tried to include fronted adverbials or cohesive devices, both within and across paragraphs, to capture the reader's attention.
- Added and subtracted fractions using our knowledge of equivalence.
- Revisited our understanding of how to stay safe on the internet.
- Discussed how we would react in dangerous situations.

Our topic of 'Blast Off!' continues into Term 4 where we shall be;

- Understanding the act of gravity on a falling object
- Understanding the effect of air resistance, water resistance an friction between moving surfaces
- Recognising that some mechanisms allow a smaller force to have a greater effect

Half Term Activities

The usual homework will return in Term 4 but below are some suggested activities to have a go at during the half term break.

- Design and/or build a vehicle suitable to be used on another planet in our Solar System.
- You have been selected as the first pupil from Lenham to go to space. Write a letter accepting the challenge. Explain why you are suited to the role and how you will cope with the challenges (being away from home, living in zero gravity, sleeping and eating).
- List 10 things you would take with you to space. Why would you take them? What makes them special? What couldn't you be without and why?
- Research a mission to space (e.g. Apollo 11, Space Shuttle flights, the first cosmonaut, building the International Space Station)
- Plan a space themed party for children. What food would you serve? What type of games would you play? Are there particular music you would play at the party?

If you chose to complete any of the above activities we would love you to bring in your completed work on Monday 19th February.
