Buster's book club

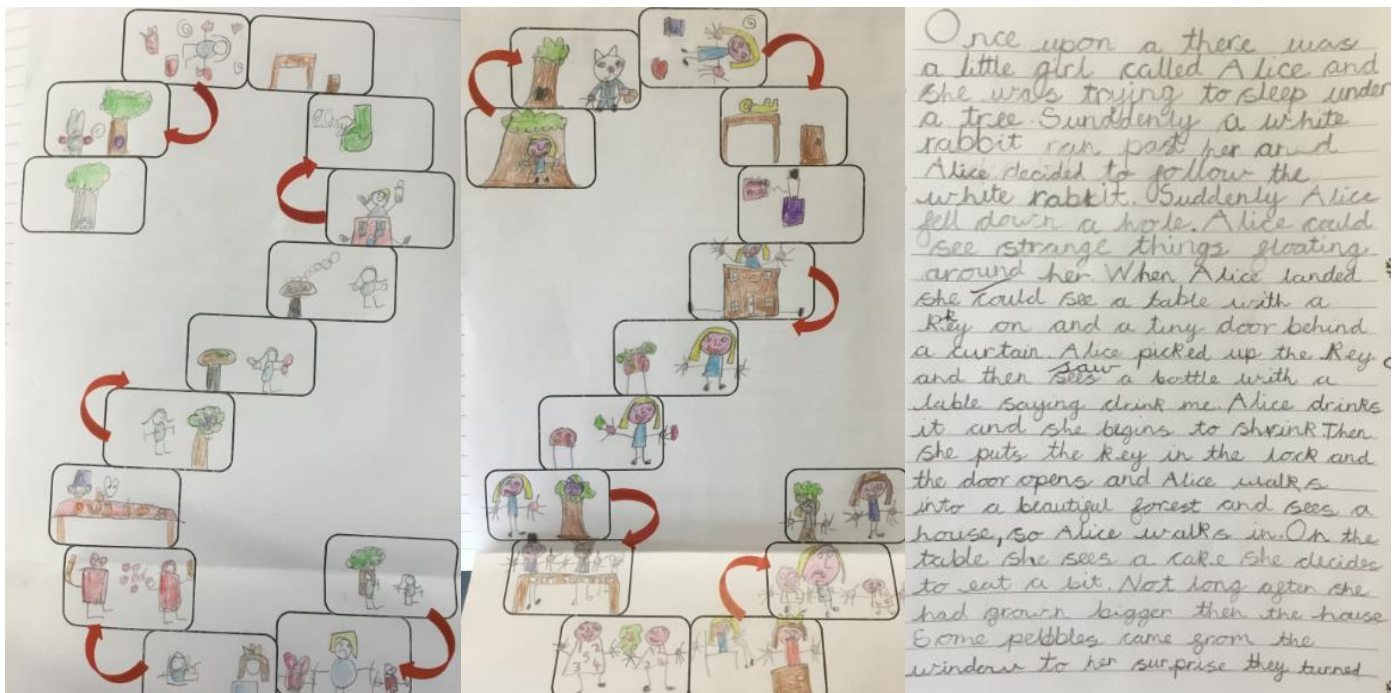
