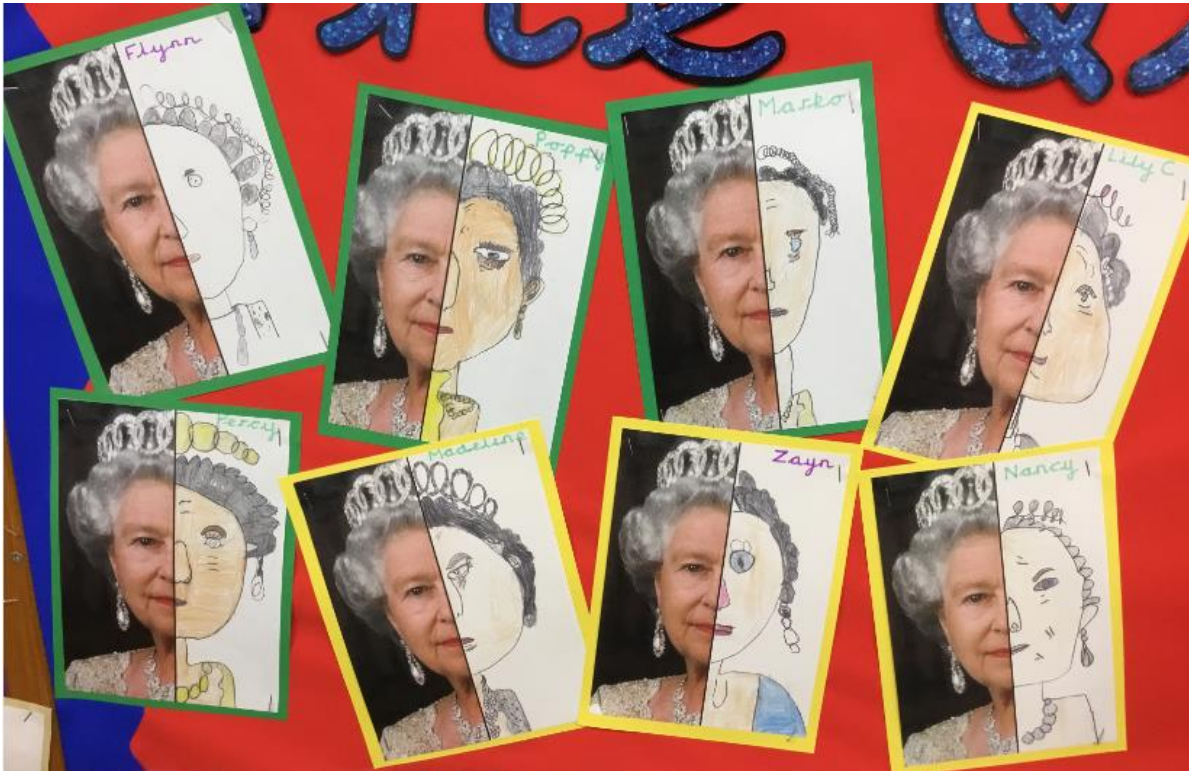
This week's homework is all about halving! Instructions and an example are on the sheet ☺
