This week in Year 4 the children have:

- Created and planned for a new character and setting for their own chapter of Charlie and the Chocolate Factory.
- Planned their chapter and started to write the introduction to this chapter.
- Learned about the simple past and present perfect tense in Grammar.
- Recapped rounding to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000.
- Found 1000 more or less than a given number, ordered numbers, counted in multiples of 25 and 50 and counted backwards through zero into negative numbers.
- Learned the French names of places in the town.
- Practised dribbling, sending and receiving in hockey.
- Made their own mini chocolate bars and packaging.

## Homework:

Homework this week is a Maths sheet linked to counting back through zero. I have also sent home a number line to help the children complete the questions. Homework needs to be completed and returned by Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> October. As usual, the children also need to read for 20 minutes ideally every night and practise their spelling words and times table facts please.
