Next week: Story book-'Dear Zoo'

This week I have been

- continuing my phonics learning and readiness for reading-learning about segmenting and blending
- developing my readiness for writing by using anticlockwise movements
- thinking of some simple questions about monkeys using where, why, how and what
- enjoying the story 'Monkey Puzzle'
- learning the correct names for baby animals (ask me what a baby mouse is called-even Mrs Catmull was surprised!)
- planting a bulb so that I can record it's growth over time
- introduced to Numicon maths resources
- counting objects or actions that cannot be moved
- matching numerals to represent groups of objects
- learning to draw a number two correctly
- learning to throw and catch a bean bag

In practise time I have been able to

Role play- house inside & book shop outside

- explore Numicon shapes by using them in the play dough
- develop my imagination by creating a monkey mask and learning how to mix the colour brown
- use pencil control to draw around circle shapes
- complete a jungle themed puzzle with smaller pieces
- · develop my fine motor skills by threading beads
- play a board game with my friends-'Five Little Monkeys'
 Outdoor play
- explore Numicon in the water tray
- observe Autumn objects using a magnifying glass
- play a balancing board game with my friends-'Monkey Business'
- stamp circles in the wet sand

At home you can help me to

- count a number of items accurately and add the correct numeral to match the set (starting with 0-6)
- learn more about baby animals by completing the resource sheet placed inside my Busy Book
- play 'I Spy' to consolidate my ability to hear initial sounds
- clap the sounds in simple words i.e. c/a/t or s/o/ck using one clap for each phoneme
- develop my muscles for writing by helping me to draw circles using an anticlockwise action
- visit a garden centre and perhaps buy a bulb to plant and grow

Next Week I will be

- learning to recite and act the story of 'Dear Zoo'
- introduced to the names of simple 2D shapes
- starting Phase 2 of my phonic learning-s/a/t/p
