- develop my imagination by making pretend pumpkin soup

• identify and name 'flat' 2D shapes e.g. circle, square, rectangle, triangle, heart, diamond, star, semi circle. Can I find any of these around the house or outside?

- practice writing my name tracing over a model or copying underneath if needed
- retell a story in my own words maybe adding some actions to make it exciting
- draw an animal that I might see in a zoo in my Busy Book and add the animal name label

- starting a new learning theme!
- starting Phase 2 of my phonic learning-s/a/t/p (postponed this week due to other events)
