MY WEEK IN RAINBOW CLASS w/c 5.11.18

Theme: 'The Hindu Festival of Diwali'

Next week: Story book- 'Kipper's Birthday'

This week I have been

- learning to hear and recognise the phonemes i,m,n,d
- practising the correct formation of the letters i,m,n,d-remembering to start each letter shape on the line and to retrace the vertical line in each letter
- copying, continuing and creating patterns
- learning how to keep healthy
- learning about the story of Rama and Sita and how Hindus celebrate the festival of Diwali
- making clay diva lamps

In practise time I have been able to

Role play- party house inside & construction site outside

- explore the role play area and write lists of party food
- develop my imagination by creating rangoli patterns, drawing 10 heads on Ravana and decorating pictures of Hanuman the monkey God
- develop my gross motor skills by moulding play dough into shapes and imprinting patterns
- to make patterns with pegs and peg boards, beads and cubes
- use vegetables dipped in paint to print patterns
 Outdoor play
- explore our construction site and new resources
- play a pattern board game with my friends
- use natural materials to make patterns
- practice riding the balance bikes

At home you can help me to

- talk about the patterns I see around me. Can I make a repeating pattern using things I find inside and outside? (i.e. toy cars, teddies, coloured and shaped leaves)
- match, read and maybe write simple words using the phonemes we have learnt this week by completing the sheet in my Busy Book
- practice retracing vertical lines from bottom to top and down and up again, to help form 'm' and 'n' correctly (see handwriting guide in handout given out at consultations)
- investigate the changes that exercise has on my body by feeling my heart beating and how my breathing changes before and after doing 10 star jumps!

Next Week I will be

- learning the phonemes-g/o/c/k
- thinking how we celebrate birthdays and learning about other occasions we celebrate
- being introduced to working with money in maths
