This week we have continued our work on fractions. We have learnt how to recognise and find one half, one quarter and one third (all called unit fractions). Next week we shall be learning about non-unit fractions. These are $\frac{2}{4}$, $\frac{3}{4}$, $\frac{2}{3}$ s. Then we shall be counting in fractions!

In English we have looked at a book called 'Free Fall' by David Wiesner. It is a picture book which tells the story of a boy's dream. The illustrations are amazing and it has really inspired the children to write about their own dreams. Their vocabulary and punctuation is really improving and I was very proud of their efforts.

Next week is Science week and we have lots of science lessons planned, and there are several visitors coming in to run experiments and investigations.
