- fish for shapes in the water tray using the nets

- practice my reading daily and help me to recognise words that are repeated in the book so that I do not have to decode them every time I meet them
- talk about photos of myself as a baby or my brothers and sisters when they were babies. Talk about what I could and could not do as a baby
- go on a 3D/solid shape spotting walk around the house or outside
