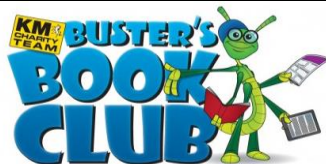
Out of school ...

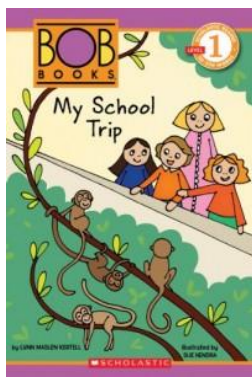

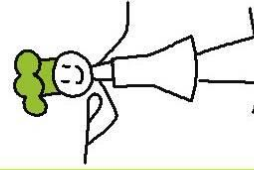
