This week we have been:

- Focusing on voice sounds in phonics (sssss like snake, zzzzz like a bee)
- Beginning to segment words into sounds -c-a-t cat, h-o-t, hot
- Reading 'Cleversticks' and talking about what we are good at using the word 'because'
- Counting Numicon and matching to numerals, reading numerals and making towers using the correct number
- Learning about our sense of taste and describing different tastes
- Understanding that changes occur over time and counting the days until our hyacinth bulb blooms
- Reading Bumblebear and learning how stories are structured, sequencing the story using pictures
- Creating bumble bees and bee hive artwork
- Drawing self-portraits using our photos of ourselves
- Learning new songs and understanding how songs make us feel and move
- Continuing to write our names and starting to write the numerals 1,2,3
