This week we have:

- Learnt how to subtract two digits from two digits. We are using the column method. For some of us we also learned how to use exchange to 'cross the ten'.
- We have been introduced to our new class story 'The Rabbit Who Stole the Fire'. This is a traditional native American tale about the origin of fire. We have predicted the ending and been introduced to the main characters. We have also begun to learn to tell the story using actions.
- We have begun learning about The Great Fire of London. We have sequenced the timeline of events and worked together to brainstorm what the people could see, hear, feel, smell and possibly taste during the fire.
