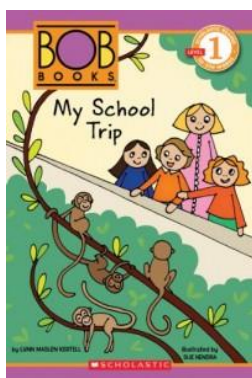
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## Trips for September 2019- July 2020



As requested through parent voice, as a school we are trying to give you a rough guide to trips and events which will cost money, so that you can plan. Final figures will be confirmed nearer the time.

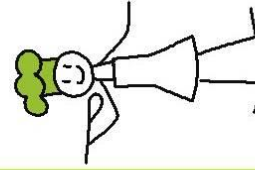
