

This week we have:

- Converted fractions to decimals and vice versa before moving onto calculating percentages.
- Edited and improved our own stories written to create suspense and atmosphere.
- Explored and recited the poem 'The Angel' written by William Blake, and written our own poems about Skellig.
- Investigated synonyms (words that are similar in meaning) and antonyms (words that are opposite in meaning).
- Explored the characteristics that can be passed on to the offspring of living things, as well as extracting the DNA of a strawberry!

Next week we shall be:

- Continuing to calculate using percentages.
- Completing a further 'trial run' of some of the Maths SAT papers.
- Taking part in a debate before exploring the features of balanced arguments in order to plan our own.
- Completing a practice reading comprehension assessment.
- Continuing our Science topic, exploring how living things have changed, evolved and adapted over time and how fossils
 provide information.
- Beginning our RE unit entitled 'What do religions say when life gets hard?' Please read the <u>Further Information</u> box below for important details of the unit.

Homework:

For **English** this week, the children have been given a new 'Spag Spotter' Grammar worksheet. Their task is to identify specific word classes within given sentences. This is due for completion by **Thursday 30**th **January**.

New spelling words have been issued and uploaded to Spelling Shed. The children need to practise these words in readiness for their spelling test next Friday.

Please continue to encourage your child to read every night and record their reading in their Homework Diary. Some of the children have finished their first reading book this term and are recommending books to each other! On Thursday, 19 children brought in their signed reading bookmarks. Just a handful of children had remembered to record their **daily reading** in their diaries. Reading books and homework diaries must be brought into school and then taken home again every day. Thank you for your continued support with this.

For **Maths** this week, the children have been set two tasks. Firstly, they have been given a worksheet on 'converting fractions to decimals'. The children will need to use their knowledge of short division, remembering to use a zero as a place holder to continue the division. Secondly, they are being asked to complete **3 progressions on Maths Whizz.** The learning platform has been set to focus on percentages as this will help to consolidate knowledge from the lessons. This homework is due for completion by **Thursday 30**th **January.**
