Hopefully you saw yesterday our new video from the staff to you.

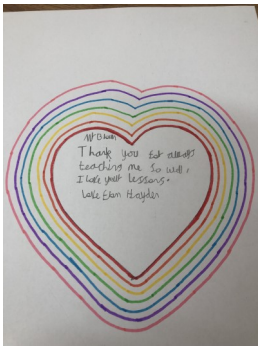

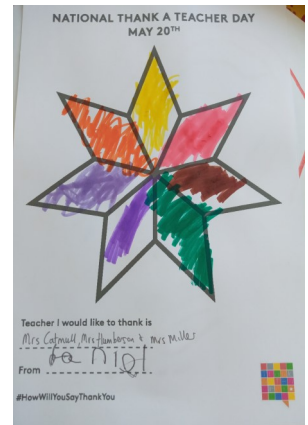
## Teacher Appreciation Week

Miss Crayford and Mrs Best

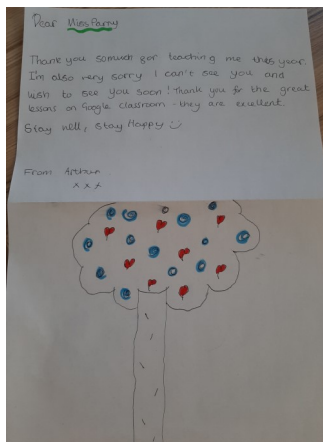
From Grace - Year 1

Thank you for being the best teacher forever!

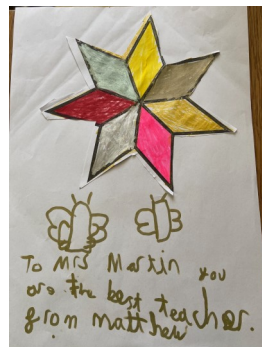
I love you Miss Crayford you are the bestest teacher I have ever had.

I love how you teach me and I love writing.

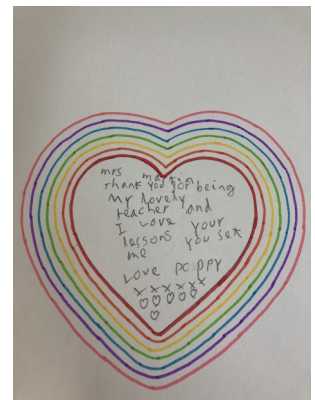


From Ethan to all the reception class teachers: I liked it at school when it was playtime, and when you helped me

## Virtual Competition Week 5



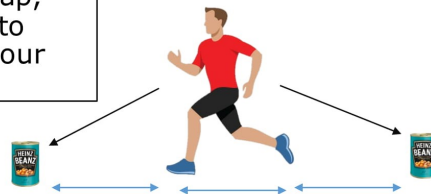

### Top tips

- Side step between may be quicker
- Keep looking up
- Try to use both hands e.g. if running to the right use your right hand to tap, when running to your left use your left

### Equipment

- 2 tins or cans
- A timer
- Someone to count



### Challenge...

In this challenge you need to use your speed and agility to change direction quickly. Set out your cans 3 giant steps apart (make sure it's the participants giant steps). In the set time, run as many times as you can from one tin to the other.

**Key stage 1**, you should continue for 20 seconds.

**Key stage 2**, you should continue for 30 seconds.

**Key stage 3 & 4**, you should continue for 40 seconds.

*Try to improve on your score throughout the week then ask an adult to email me with your name, school and best score on Friday. We will then have a virtual competition, I will put all of the scores together over the weekend and send out the results on the Monday along with the next week's challenge. There will be a top 3 awarded for every year group across all the schools that I teach in, these children will receive a "virtual certificate". We don't want the adults to miss out so they are more than welcome to join in, top 3 adults will be awarded a certificate too!
