Pupils are meeting the minimum 30-minute target of daily exercise in school. Profile of PESSPA being raised across the school – Presence of Mr Holliday raises the profile of PESSPA, provides children with a role model and encourages children to take part. 			<p>Increase knowledge, skills and confidence of staff when teaching PE – Mr Holliday has PE slots with all classes every week. He is able to lead parts of the lesson, set up activities and equipment and offer advice to teachers. Teachers should become more confident in teaching PE, more able to differentiate their lessons (to work with specific groups) and be better prepared as they will not have to set up the lesson in advance.</p> <p>Broader range of sports and activities offered to pupils – Regular after school clubs which cover a broad range of sports. A schedule of clubs and competitions has been drawn up in Term 1. The Greenacre Scheme/ Cornerstones also provides a range of sports to be taught. Pupils trying new sports and hopefully encouraging more reluctant pupils to find a sport they enjoy.</p> <p>Increased participation in competitive sport – Mr Holliday is to lead a competition every term hosted by Lenham Primary School. A Schedule of competitions has been drawn up in Term 1 and local school contacted to see if they want to take part. Intra competitions have also been planned, similar to those we have had in the past from the Lenham School, so that there is 100% pupil engagement in some form of competition. Aiming for 100% pupil engagement in some form of competition.</p>	Record pupil participation in clubs and competitions.
