### **Help for household energy bills – support available from Kent County Council.**

**Residents have until the end of March - or when the funding is spent - to apply for vouchers that can be used to help pay your home energy bill.**

#### ***Now more residents can apply***

The new eligibility criteria for the £100 energy voucher are:

- aged 16 or over
- a Kent resident, permanently living within one of the 12 local authorities covered by Kent County Council (this excludes Medway, Bromley and Bexley)
- in receipt of means-tested benefits, or household income is less than £30,000 per year before tax
- savings not above £250
- not be receiving free school meals support for any child within your household (in a separate scheme, families who are supported with free school meal vouchers in the holidays will also receive a £50 voucher per eligible child to be used to support with home energy costs. This will be issued to them via their child's school).

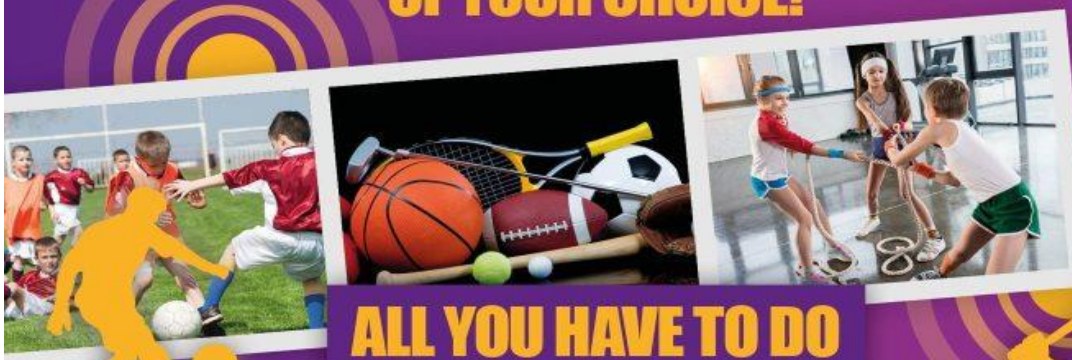
