






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Dear Parents and Carers of Lenham Primary School,

Kent PACT would like to invite you to a coffee morning on Wednesday 6th November at 9:15-10.00 to discuss the PINS project pilot.

What is the PINS project?

PINS stands for 'Partnerships for Inclusion of Neurodiversity in Schools'.

It is a project that helps schools to improve the experience of children who are neurodivergent so that they feel welcomed, supported and able to take part in all aspects of school life.

PINS is a national initiative led by the Department for Education and NHS England.

In Kent, 20 primary schools, including Lenham Primary School, in Maidstone are taking part in the project. This is an exciting pilot for your school to be a part of, as the discussions and feedback that we collect from our sessions with you will help to inform how SEND support is rolled out in all schools in the future.

The meeting/drop in is open to all parent carers of children at Lenham Primary School with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND). SEND is defined as any child that has a learning difficulty or disability that make it harder for a child to learn compared to children of the same age. Children with Special Educational Needs (SEN) are likely to need extra or different help from that given to other children their age. This help is known as special educational provision.



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How will PINS help my child?

PINS will help your child by improving their school environment and helping schools adapt the way they do things to meet your child's needs (which could include mental health, speech and language and physical and sensory) to help them learn and take part in all aspects of school life.

PINS will help all pupils in school - children don't need a formal diagnosis to benefit from this project.

How will PINS help parents?

PINS will help parents to build strong relationships and improve communication with their child's school so that they can have more confidence in how the school is supporting their child's needs.

Parents' views and experiences are a vital part of this project. Kent PACT (Parents and Carers Together - the local parent/carer forum) will hold forums like coffee mornings and other events for parents so that they can share their feedback, knowledge and ideas with other parents and their child's school.

By working together, parents, carers and schools can support each other to give children the best experiences of school.

We cannot stress how important parents and carers views and opinions are as part of the PINS project. Together with your school and Kent PACT we look forward to meeting you and telling you more about the pilot and discussing ways we can all work together to support all children and make their education experience a positive and rewarding one.
