Applying for a place in Year 7....

- Secondary Common Application Form (SCAF) can be completed on line www.kent.gov.uk/ola
- Parents are invited to express up to 4 school preferences, ranked in order of their preference
- Parents can give reasons for preference including details of any siblings still on roll at that specific school
- ► A place will be offered (on National Offer Day March 2026) at the highest available ranked preference which the child is eligible to attend.
- If a school cannot be offered at a school named on the form, a place will be offered at an alternative.
- Pupils with an EHCP do not apply to schools for a place through the main round admissions process

Accepting a place in Year 7....

- On Offer Day Monday 2nd March 2026 parents will be given
 - Name of school offered
 - Reasons why child is not offered place at other schools named
 - Information about statutory right to appeal for other schools named on SCAF
 - Information about how to request a place on a waiting list. Parents cannot request a place on a list for a grammar school unless the child has been assessed as suitable for a grammar school.
 - ▶ Date to accept or refuse the offer and where or when to lodge an appeal.
- If your child has an EHCP then your application does not follow the main admission process and is directed via KCC Special Educational Needs Services.

Secondary School Questions / Advice



Before completing your application for a secondary school place we advise parents to.....

- Visit as many school websites as possible (we would normally recommend visiting the schools at a range of different times)
- Take your child with you where possible but do try and visit on your own too.
- Look at the school's website and how they promote themselves.
- Look at the oversubscription criteria for each school you would like to apply for.
- Go to Open Days/Talks/Taster Days/Online Events.
- Talk about if your child can easily get to school....be realistic, think about transport options.

Continued...

- What subjects are offered?
- Applicable to your child's interests?
- What qualifications do they offer.... How are they delivered?
- Sixth Form facilities?
- % that go on to College/University/Apprenticeships?
- O Development plans for the next 3 years?
- Ask about your areas of concern eg. Discipline, SEN, pastoral support.
