We are fast approaching the end of term for this academic year and Caterlink would like to inform you of the end of year process for school meals:

- Please try to load onto your child's accounts the amount needed for meals until the end of term. Credit balances for children in only Years 3, 4 and 5 will be held over to the next academic year.
- All debit balances **MUST** be cleared. Caterlink do not offer a credit service, and you will be informed if your account is in deficit.
- All children in Year 2, moving to Year 3 in September will be charged for meals from September unless they are registered for income based free school meals. If you think you may be entitled to income based free school meals, please apply here https://apply.cloudforedu.org.uk/ofsm/kent or contact the school office who can do this on your behalf.
- The price of school meals will increase to £3.05 from September 2025
