Cabin Coffee is open every Friday. BUT we are changing. From Term 6 we will be selling cans of drink and Fruit Shoots for £1.



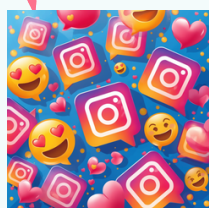
